Qualified applicants will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis; therefore, we encourage timely submission of applications. If an applicant cannot be placed in their first choice, they will be enrolled in their second choice. If a session fills, additional applicants will be notified and given the option of being placed on a waiting list. Nature Camp cannot hold spaces without an application for a specific camper.					
All campers should be in good mental, emotional, and social health and be able to participate fully in classes, prepare written projects, and participate in rigorous outdoor activities. All accepted campers must pass a physical examination; a health history form to be completed by a physician will be sent to each camper and must be returned before the start of camper's session.
